

Dr. Anita Brentley Community Engaged Health Research Scholar Award

The *Anita Brentley Community-Engaged Health Research Scholar Award* is awarded to up to 2 graduate students enrolled in the Community-Engaged Research for Health graduate certificate each academic year to cover tuition and fees for curriculum courses. Eligible applicants will be considered for this award, sponsored by the [Center for Clinical and Translational Science and Training](#) based on merit and area of study.

Eligible students must be enrolled in the Community-Engaged Research for Health graduate certificate and an employee of a non-profit organization. New applicants must apply before courses begin to be considered. Awardees are asked to submit a brief survey each semester for grade verification and evaluation tracking. Current awardees will be considered for scholarship renewal each year prior to the fall semester based on their academic performance.

Students are *not* eligible for this award if they:

1. are taking classes as non-matriculated students,
2. are employed by an academic institution full or part-time,
3. have not maintained satisfactory progress to meet the minimum GPA of 3.0,
4. are on academic probation, or
5. have exceeded the [174 rule](#).

Awards can only be guaranteed for a maximum period of one academic year, and renewal of this graduate award is not automatic. Awards that are appointed by individual programs are awarded at the sole discretion of the program, provided that a student is eligible for the award. Programs are not obligated to renew awards for prior awardees, even if previously awarded students met all minimum guidelines.

To apply, submit the following materials to Stacey Gomes (Stacey.Gomes@cchmc.org):

- **Personal Statement (no more than 3 pages, double-spaced)**
 - o Describing interest in the certificate program and community engagement or outreach, as well as how community-engaged research will contribute to their academic goals or current work within their organization
- **Letter of recommendation**
